Extras are charged in arrears, so they appear on school bills at the **end of the term in which they are incurred**. All school clubs and activities run by our own staff, which do not require equipment expenditure are not charged for. Children volunteering for clubs and activities costing £80 or less each term and Sunday activities costing less than £35 per weekend will be permitted to join **without** prior reference to parents, those over this cost will require permission. Permission is also required for the following:

Occasional Boarding:	£59.54 per night (up to 3 nights per week)
Learning Support** (1 to 1):	£42.65 for a 30-minute lesson (pro-rata depending on length)
Music*:	£38.93 for a 35-minute lesson, plus music scores and examination fees (Hire charge - for orchestral instruments: £60.48)
LAMDA**:	20 minute lessons (grade 1-3) Individual £14.50 each; Duo £10.50 each per pupil per session. 30 minutes lessons (grade 4+) Individual £21.74 each; Duo £15.75 each per pupil per session. Plus any examination fees
Tennis*:	Individual lessons £45.00 each; £23.81 each for pairs lessons; groups £15.88 per person per lesson
Cricket*:	Individual lessons £45.00 each; £23.81 each for pairs lessons
Clubs & Activities:	(e.g. Sailing, Riding, Fencing): Examination, competition and membership fees
Golf / Mountain Biking*:	Up to £26.46 per session for group sessions
Acorns Clubs:	Up to £9.35 per session for those sessions if done by external professionals (e.g. tennis)
Minibus service:	Cost available from Bursar
Day children supper/breakfast:	£3.97 per meal
Birthday cakes:	£13.23
Overseas Trips:	£500 - £1,000 dependant on destination
Leavers' Trips:	Parental Contribution £680.00
Year 8 Leavers' Activities:	Parental Contribution £200.00

*Activities marked ** require a term's notice / * require half a term's written notice from parents before a child is withdrawn.*

In addition to the above, children may incur charges for various other items such as:

Bookfair and bookshop, theatre trips and outings, T-shirt designing and jewellery making, pocket money for trips, stationery (more expensive items only – pencils, rubbers etc are included in the school fees), breakages and damage to property.

The School reserves the right to recharge any costs incurred in relation to a child's place, fees or admission to Packwood.
